**Work Session Minutes**

Mayor Eveland called the work session to order at 6:30 p.m. Mayor Eveland indicated that the Council would be going into Executive Session first and the Regular Work Session would follow.

**Resolution of Approval**

Resolution #11-158                      Authorizing the Council to Enter Into Executive Session

Councilman Wikstrom made a motion to approve Resolution # 11-158, seconded by Council President Taylor.

The Mayor and Council entered into Executive Session.

At 6:45 p.m. the Mayor and Council returned to the Work Session.

Mayor Eveland asked the Council to provide updates on their individual portfolios.

Councilman Wikstrom indicated that he would like to discuss the fact that he believes the Senior Center needs to have someone supervising it. Recreation Director Adam Lieb was also in attendance and stated that he would like to leave Vinnie Maguilli on at a rate of \$15.00 per hour; which is the rate typically paid to seasonal employees. He further indicated that funds are available in the Recreation Department budget for this purpose. Councilman Huyler stated that he thinks the Senior Center should be manned by a Borough Employee and believes it is money well spent.

The Council agreed to keep Vinnie on at the rate of \$15.00 per hour for a three month period and see how that goes. The Council indicated they would revisit the matter in three months. The Council requested that the Clerk prepare a Payroll Authorization form.

Mayor Eveland opened the meeting to the public. Seeing no members of the public who wished to be heard, Mayor Eveland closed the meeting to the public.

Councilman Taylor arrived at 7:05 p.m. as the Work Session was ending.

At 7:05 p.m., on a motion made by Councilman Wikstrom and duly seconded, the work session was adjourned by a unanimous vote.
