**ORDINANCE # 11-18**

AN ORDINANCE REAPPROPRIATING \$210,000.00 OF OBLIGATIONS NOT NEEDED FOR THEIR ORIGINAL PURPOSES IN ORDER TO PROVIDE FOR IMPROVEMENTS FOR ROADS AND SIDEWALKS

**BE IT HEREBY ORDAINED** BY THE BOROUGH COUNCIL OF THE BOROUGH OF FLORHAM PARK, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, NEW JERSEY( not less than two-thirds of all members thereof affirmatively concurring) AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A 40A:2-39, it is hereby determined that the following proceeds of obligations originally made available pursuant to the bond ordinance listed below are no longer necessary for the following purposes:

Ordinance No.	Description	Amount to be re-appropriated
06-14	Diesel Exhaust Extractor, Bucket Truck, and Solar Message Board	\$176,600.00
06-14	Refurbishing of Stobaesus Playground and Installation of Safety Fencing	\$ 16,900.00
06-14	Architectural/Planning Services for the Expansion of Fire Department Headquarters	\$ 16,500.00

Section 2. pursuant to N.J.S.A.40A:2.39, it is hereby determined that \$210,000.00 of the proceeds of obligations referred to above are hereby re-appropriated to provide for Improvements to Roads and Sidewalks

Section 3. The capital budget of the Borough of Florham Park is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
