




BRUSH & LIMB PICKUP will begin the week of **March 21, 2016**, weather permitting, and will be conducted once a month during the last full workweek (that's Monday through Friday) of the month continuing through the week of **September 26, 2016**. Leave brush curbside by 7:00 a.m. on Monday and **do not place brush in the roadway**. **Once a roadway is completed there will be no return trips until the following month**. LARGE BRANCH CHIPPING between 1 inch and 6 inches in diameter with a length greater than 4 feet will be chipped. SMALL BRANCH CHIPPING Branches and cuttings less than 1 foot in diameter may be tied in bundles no longer than 4' and placed curbside, or in rigid receptacle which does not contain grass or garden debris. **Grass and Garden Debris Pickup Route 1** begins the week of **April 4, 2016**, and **Route 2** pickups begin **April 11 2016**. Dump **no dog waste** in these cans, please. Pickups will continue through the week of **October 24, 2016**. Plastic containers, metal cans and all biodegradable bags are acceptable containers; however, **no plastic bags may be used at any time**.



HEAVY ITEM PICKUP

There will be two (2) pickups scheduled in 2016; the week of **May 2, 2016** and the week of **September 12, 2016**. **All residents must register the items to be picked up**, by telephoning the Department of Public Works by calling 973-410-5330 with their name, address, telephone number and items list, no later than the Thursday preceding the scheduled collection. **Failure to call on time will result in missing the pickup, if items are to be added, please re-call and add to the list originally given**. Items that will not be picked up include oil tanks, windows, sliding glass doors, mirrors, tires, propane tanks, construction or demolition debris, firewood, logs, stumps, quantities of fencing, railroad ties or items in plastic garbage bags. No glass, plastic bags, or paint will be accepted and we request that you please separate wood from metal, making 2 piles.

COMPUTERS, MONITORS, AND TELEVISIONS ARE NO LONGER ACCEPTED FOR HEAVY ITEM PICKUP (OR WEEKEND DROP OFF AT THE COLUMBIA TPK. ENVIRONMENTAL CENTER.)

Appliances such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers or any other items that have a compressor known to contain Freon will not be picked up unless the DCS office has been provided with documentation indicating that the Freon has been legally removed.

(Please check www.njcleanenergy.com to see if a refrigerator/freezer recycling program is in effect, or call 877-270-3520 for information as **you may be entitled to a rebate**). All items must be at curbside by 6:30 a.m. the Monday of each collection week.

RULES FOR FLORHAM PARK ENVIRONMENTAL CENTER

DRIVERS LICENSE OR ANOTHER FORM OF PROOF OF FLORHAM PARK RESIDENCY MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE ATTENDANT BEFORE DUMPING

Items not accepted:

- Oil tanks
- Tires
- Propane tanks
- Firewood
- Logs
- Stumps
- Quantities of fencing
- Railroad ties
- Items in plastic bags
- Household garbage
- Plastic bags
- Wooden pallets
- Paint (unless uncapped & dried out)
- Treated wood, bamboo

Also not accepted are:

- Televisions
- Computers
- Monitors

Items such as refrigerators, freezers, air conditioners, dehumidifiers, or any other item containing Freon will not be accepted unless the DPW office has been provided with written documentation indicating that the Freon has been legally removed from the item. Check with www.njcleanenergy.com to see if a refrigerator/freezer recycling program is in effect.

Vehicles not allowed at Environmental Center:

- Trailers
- Commercial vehicles
- Mason dumps
- Anything larger than a pickup truck
- Rented vehicles of any kind (U Haul, etc.)
- Any out-of-state vehicle
- Vehicles not registered to Florham Park residents

Requests for use of commercial vehicles or trailers will be considered provided you complete a request for access letter of approval from the DPW Director at Borough Hall at least 24 hours prior to access date. The letter must contain the make, model and plate number, and it must be a New Jersey vehicle registered to a resident in the Borough of Florham Park. A list of items to be transported and the proposed access date must also be provided.

The Borough of Florham Park reserves the right to refuse

at their discretion.
