**Portfolio Updates/Discussions:**

**Council President Cefolo-Pane:**

Council President Cefolo-Pane provided a brief update on the Gazebo Concerts. She stated that they concerts were going well and were well attended.

**Council President Charles Germershausen:**

Council President Germershausen stated the Rich Davidson from the Historical Preservation Commission was in attendance to discuss some matters of importance.

Mr. Davidson discussed some trees that are hanging dangerously at Hancock Cemetery. DPW Director Frank Esposito stated that they are aware of the trees and would get to them.

Mr. Davidson stated there are Grist Mill Stones on Ridgedale Avenue that belong to the Borough that were grist mill stones that belong to the Borough. They could be removed with the Ridgedale curbing project. Mayor Taylor said they are worth a lot of money, although would be very tough to move given their size.

### **Councilman Carpenter**

Councilman Carpenter indicated that the Florham Park Police Department is initiating a trading card program. It is going to be financed by a private party. He stated that he thinks this will be good for the Community in its interaction with the Police Department.

Councilman Carpenter indicated Chief Montuore had recommended a change and Ordinance to include fees for setting up and breaking down of equipment.
