**Cartons\***

**Metal cans & clean aluminum foil\*, pie plates\* & trays\***

**#1, #2 and #4\*, #5\*, #7\* plastic food & beverage containers (bottle & non-bottle\* packaging)**

**Phone books**

**Newspapers, brochures & inserts (no plastic bags, do not tie & bundle)**

**Corrugated cardboard & paper bags (flattened)**

**Cardboard beverage carriers\***

**Paperboard boxes (cereal, pasta & tissue)**

**Follow Guidelines Carefully**

**NO NEED TO REMOVE:**  
Paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, metal fasteners, cellophane address windows, rubber bands, spiral bindings, plastic tabs

- Please flatten all cardboard boxes.
- Empty and rinse all containers.
- Put all shredded paper into plastic bags (preferably clear), and tie bags securely. Don't use paper bags for shredded paper. Don't shred more paper than necessary. Shred confidential information only.
- Collection container size is limited to 32 gallons (50 lbs). Use more than one container if necessary.

**File folders & office paper**

**Glass bottles & jars**

**Junk mail, catalogs & magazines**

**Loose metal jar lids & steel bottle caps**

**Paper towel rolls**

**Paperback books**

**Not Acceptable**

- No scrap metal
- No VHS/VCR tapes
- No plastic bags
- No needles or syringes
- No window panes, mirrors, ceramics & Pyrex® dishware
- No stickers or address label sheet waste
- No plastics other than those listed
- No electronic waste (batteries, cell phones, computers, etc.)
- No paint, pesticides, oil & cleansers
- No motor oil or antifreeze containers
- No organic material and food waste
- No waxed paper or waxed cardboard
- No Styrofoam™ or paper-to-go containers
- No plastic caps
- No hard cover books
